A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per child is due at the time of registration.

SCRIP credits up to a total of \$250 will be applied to the tuition three times during the school year from June 1 to April 30.

All tuition payment plans are made through the FACTS Tuition Management Program.

Tuition Assistance is available for families needing tuition support. Applications are made online through FACTS Grant and Aid Assistance Service. *Tuition assistance does not cover registration fee, playground/lunch supervision fee, sport registration fees or Gala fee.*



Did you know that it costs \$6,700 to educate a child at St. John Bosco Catholic School? Tuition covers 26% of the cost, Subsidy pays 48% and 26% is covered with fundraising.
