From the Principal...

Dear Parents,
A lot of weather changes have occurred during the past 10 days causing cancellations and delays. With that come the inevitable questions on makeup days. For a little context, the Wisconsin State Superintendent of Education does not have the authority to waive hours of instruction statewide (you may have read a news story about the governor in Minnesota giving a blanket waiver to all school districts – the Wisconsin Governor does not have this authority either). School boards, under Wisconsin Stat. 118.38, may request a waiver from the DPI after a public hearing is held in the district. Historically, the department has not waived the hours and minutes requirement through this process. The Department of Public Instruction does not anticipate approving waivers for hours and minutes due to last week's weather. Each district has the local flexibility to determine the means by which they meet the hours and minutes standards. We have been encouraged by the Green Bay Diocese to follow the same guidelines and we do. Since 2013 the state no longer requires a 180-day calendar. Instructional minutes/hours are what we are to track during the year. I follow a state formula. Requirements for 7th and 8th graders are higher than for students in K- 6. Long story, short we have lost 1,800 minutes of instructional time thus far. **We currently will not have to make up any minutes and we have a small cushion left.** Should we be faced with the situation of making up instructional minutes my first decision would be to be in school the

Monday after Easter. Let's hope the significant weather changes are now over with for the year. I will keep you informed.
