Our Gala of Giving was held this past Saturday evening with the goal of bringing in financial resources to St. John Bosco. It was indeed a special evening of collaboration, comradery, and creativity. I would like to share my eternal thanks to Lisa Mueller, chair of the Gala, who has made it come to fruition the past 3 years, her extended family for providing additional resources and help with the evening, and the many, many, individuals who contributed, organized, did set-up/clean-up, arranged, participated and donated. It was an amusing evening of bidding, laughter, and challenges. Our Electric Moment focus was our second year of Project Lead the Way, our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) endeavor.
