Dear Parents,

We are in an environment of continual change on an hourly basis regarding the coronavirus outbreak, which was officially designated as a pandemic by the World Health Organization. With continual monitoring from several organizations I wanted to share the following information to keep you informed.

On Monday, school personnel will be calling each family to find out if you are traveling over the upcoming spring break and where you are going. They will ask the day of your departure and the day of your return. Based on that information there is a chance that a 14-day self-quarantine would need to be in place before the students could return to St. John Bosco. Right now, the entire world is in a level 2 and constantly changing. I wanted to make you aware of what could potentially happen with your family.

A question has come up as to what will happen if we do close school. Teachers are preparing some packets to go home with the students. They would be given out prior to dismissal on the last day before closure. My recommendation would be to continue to have your students read at least 20 minutes every day, play games and do some fun cooking requiring math skills that are appropriate for the age of the student.
