Mrs. Jenny Spude, Food Service Director for Sturgeon Bay School District, is committed to our St. John Bosco students' wellness, and she wants to ensure that all students have access to school meals while SJB is shut down.

School meals, **FREE OF CHARGE**, could be delivered to your homes on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays until our school reopens. Deliveries will be made via a bus route and will start on Monday, March 23. Drop off locations will be available to our families who live out of the Sturgeon Bay area, so please do not let your location stop you from receiving these meals. Think of this as a way to have a fun variety of food items in your refrigerator.

When calling, please provide the following information: The number of students to receive meals, the delivery address, and if a nut free lunch is needed.

The reservation deadline is Friday, March 20, at 12:30 p.m. School office hours are 7:30am – 12:30pm. This information will also be posted on our St. John Bosco website.

FAQs

Households receiving meals can include children any age up to 18 as well as children up to age 21 if those children receive special education services.

Meals will be delivered to all students who request it, even if you are SJB students who live outside of the Sturgeon Bay School district. Outside district deliveries will be via a marked SBSB school van with SBSB staff.

Delivery time will be between 11:00 and 12:30. Please watch for deliveries on the first Monday to help our drivers find your house/apartment.
