learning about the sport of bowling. Not only did they play some traditional bowling, but they also

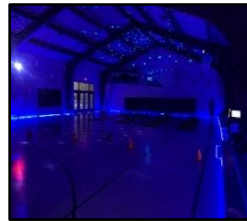


used the ball and pins to play other fun games. And what's
