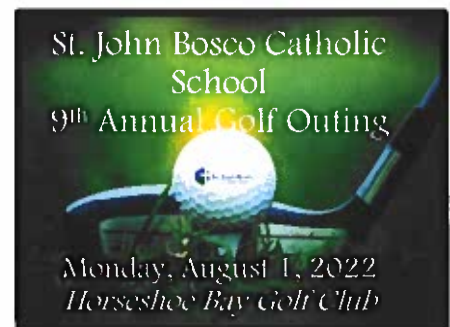
Grade 8 Graduates!
