Prizes for Raffle Ticket Sales!

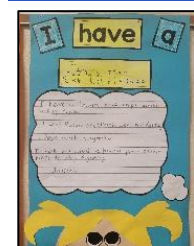

John Bosco Open House

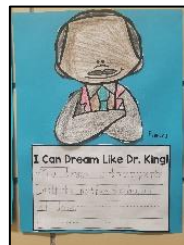
