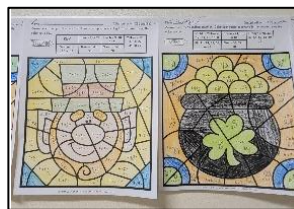
3rd St. Patrick’s Day Projects
